WHAT IS FARM DAY?

An opportunity for the public to celebrate the hands and lands that feed us through engaging and informative tours of a variety of farms, ranches and ag organizations. Farm Day is the one day out of the year where growers and the like open their doors to the public, allowing visitors to experience first hand where their food comes from. Farm Day is an annual FREE event open to all!

WHICH FARMS PARTICIPATE IN FARM DAY?

There are more than 15+ participating locations to visit on Farm Day. Locations include farms, ranches, agricultural support business, and organizations that all help to grow, harvest, and transport our food safely.

WHO ORGANIZES FARM DAY?

SEEAG (Students for Eco-Education & Agriculture), which is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization working in Ventura & Santa Barbara Counties. SEEAG's mission is to educate students and the greater community about the farm origins of our food and agriculture's contribution to our nutritional well-being.

WHAT OTHER PROGRAMS DOES SEEAG OFFER?

- Farm-to-Food Lab: free field trip to a local farm and classroom presentation, Grade 3)
- Youth Wellness Initiative: free nutrition presentation, Grade 3
- STEM Career Pathways in Agriculture: free classroom presentation, Grades 6-12

HOW MANY PEOPLE DOES FARM DAY REACH?

Last year, over 5,000 people attended.

HOW DID FARM DAY START?

The first Farm Day was held in Ventura County in 2013. It has since grown into a community-wide event, now hosted in two counties, with over 30 participating locations, and more than 10,000 combined visitors each year!

WHO ATTENDS FARM DAY?

Farm Day is for all ages!
